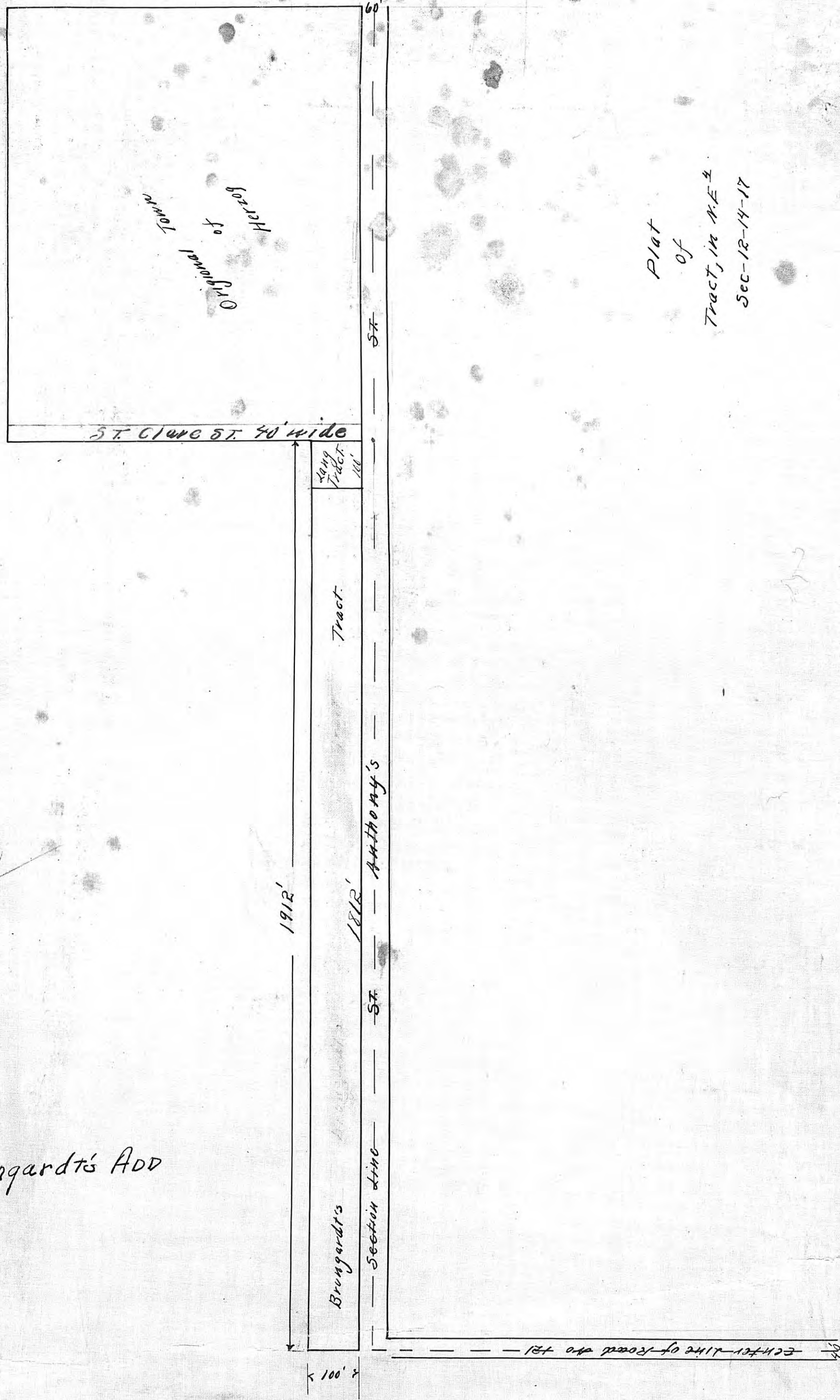

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS : THAT I B. Brungardt have caused to be surveyed and platted for record in accordance with the Laws of the State of Kansas a certain portion of the North East Quarter of Section Twelve (12), Township Fourteen (14), Range Seventeen (17) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian lying and situate in the county and state aforesaid, to be known and named as BRUNGARDT'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF VICTORIA.
