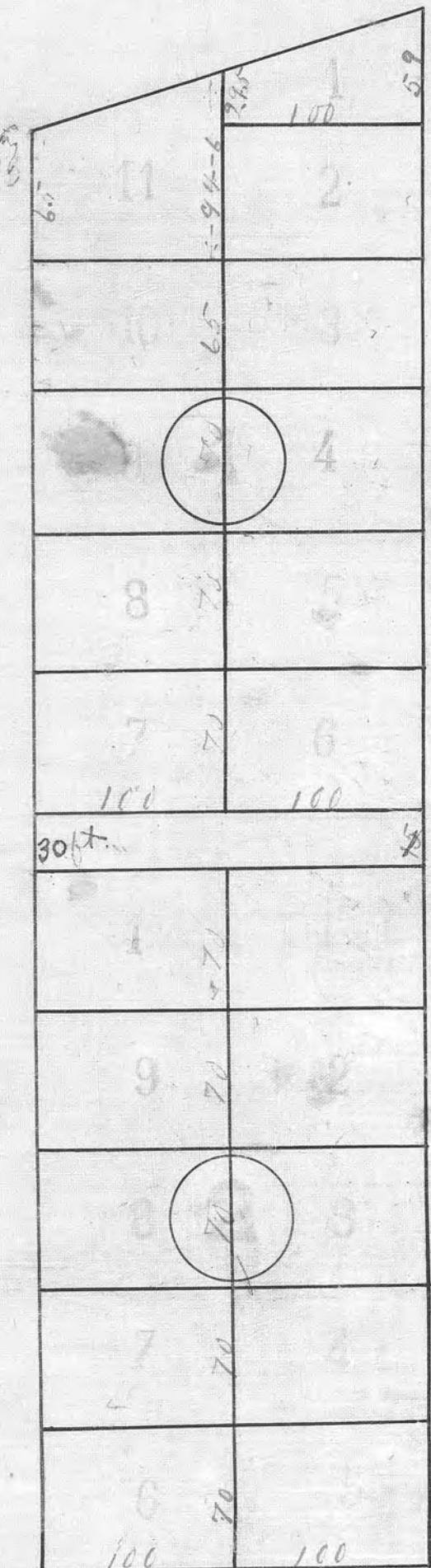
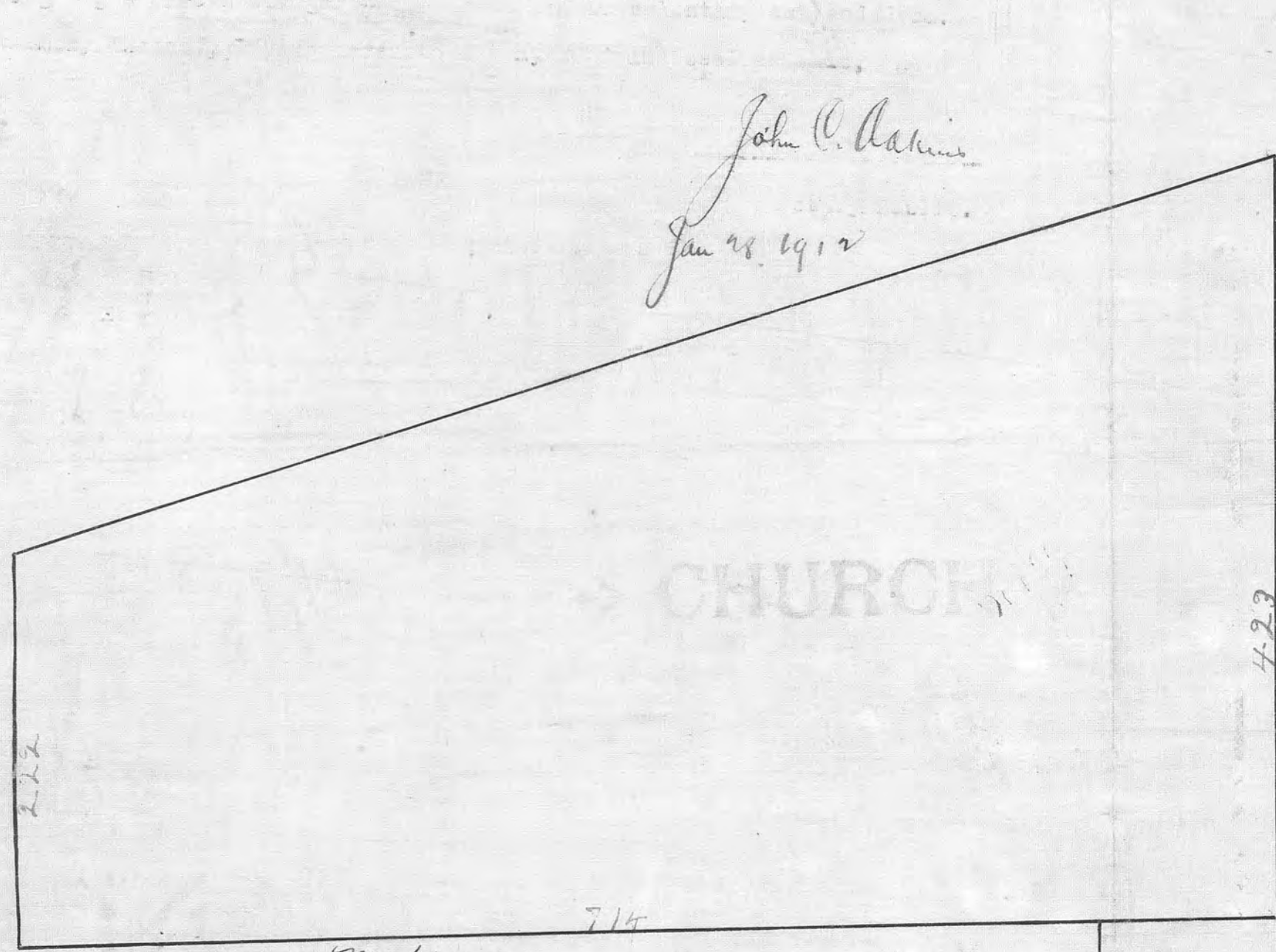

DREILING FIRST ADDITION WALKER



Dreiling's First Addition to the Town of Walker as shown on attached plat, is located on Secs 2 & 3 in Tps. 14 Rg 16, in Ellis Co. Kans.

Said Addition consists of blocks one (1) & two (2) and a plot of ground on which the Catholic Church is located. The dimensions of said plat are shown in attached diagram.

Block one (1) contains eleven (11) lots the dimensions of said block & lots being according to plat attached.

Block two (2), contains ten (10) lots the dimensions of which are set forth in plat attached.

Blocks one (1) & two (2) are separated by an alley running east & west said alley being fifteen (15) feet wide.

Blocks one (1) & two (2) are separated from church plat by a street running north & south, said street being (66) sixty-six feet wide.

On the south side of Church plat are lots one (1) & two (2) being of the dimensions as described in the plat.

The section cor. between Sec. 2 & 3 and between Tps. 13 & 14 Rg 16 in said County is 1668 feet due north of a point 10ft west of the north-west cor. of lot 11 in Blk 1, the section line between sections 2 & 3 being 10ft west of the west line of Blks 1 & 2.
