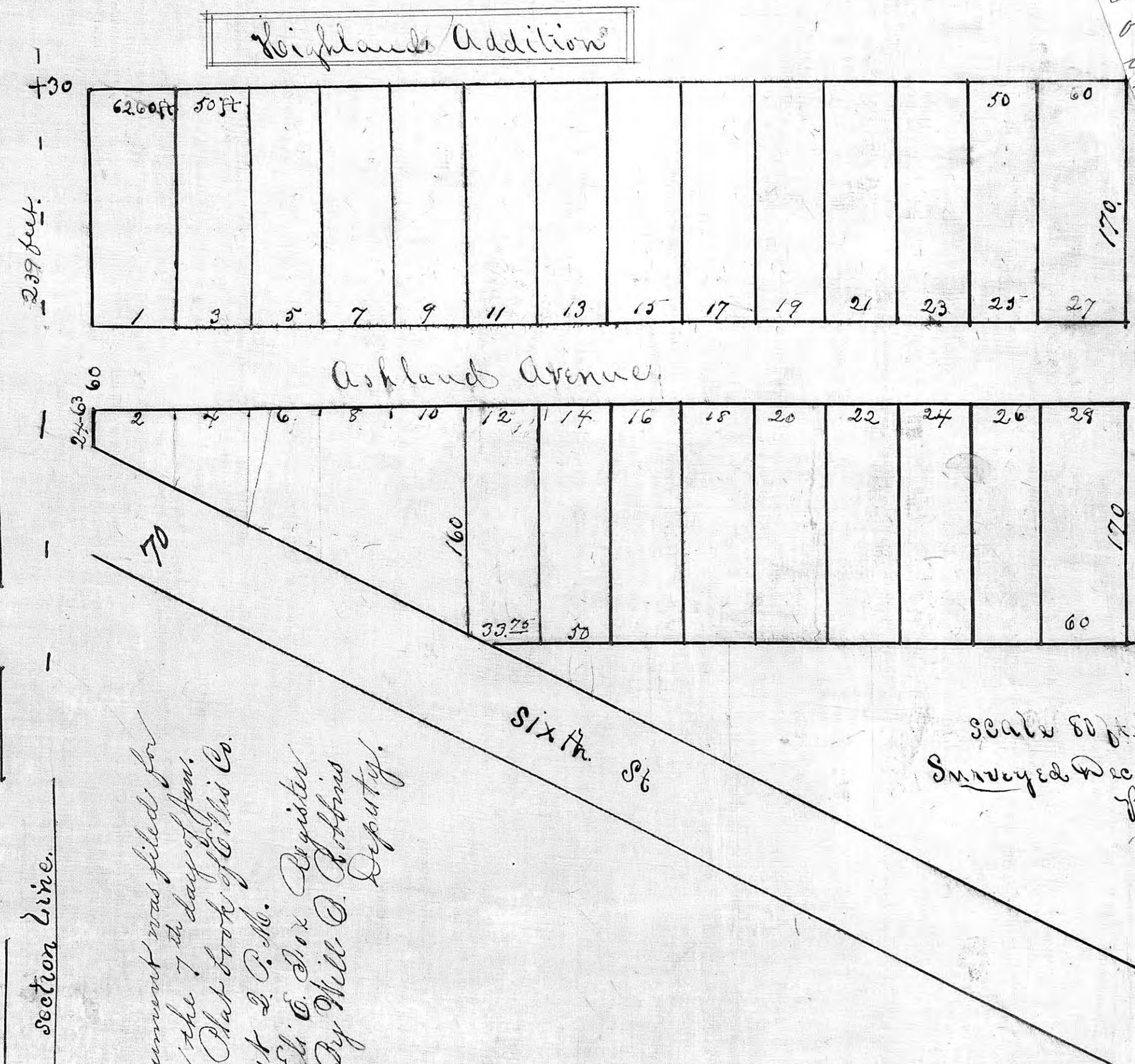

The Survey of Lots 2 and 3 of Lebold Allen and Co Addition to Hays City in to Sub divisions to wit:
 Initial Point of Beginning, The Intersection of the North line of Eighth Street, and West line of Section 33 T. 13 R. 18
 thence North var 110° 52' 239 feet to NW corner of Lot 2
 thence East var 110° 52' 782 1/2 feet to NE corner thence
 South var 110° 45' 417 feet to the S.E. corner of Lot 2
 thence west var 110° 52' and intersect North line of Eighth Street thence continue on North line of said street to the Initial Point and place of beginning
 And completing the survey of the boundary of Lots 2 & 3
 Sub division of the above Lots 2 & 3 to wit: on the west line a Street 30 ft wide Parallel to said Section line - and a Street 30 feet wide Parallel to East Boundary of Lots 2 & 3 and a Street of 60 feet wide running East & West on the line between Lots 2 & 3 (Being 50 feet of the South line of Lot 3 and 30 feet of the North line of Lot 2) also Lot 3 subdivided to wit: Beginning on the East end leaving 30 feet for street on the NE cor of Lot 3 thence East 1st lot 60 ft then 12 lots 50 ft and last Lot on west side 62 1/2 ft then 30 feet to Sec line between 33 & 34
