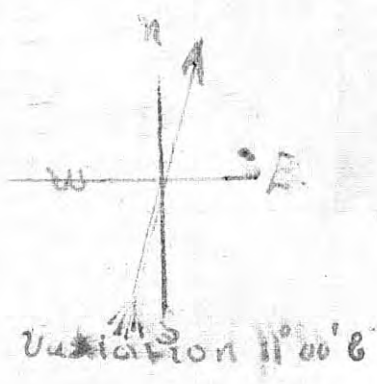
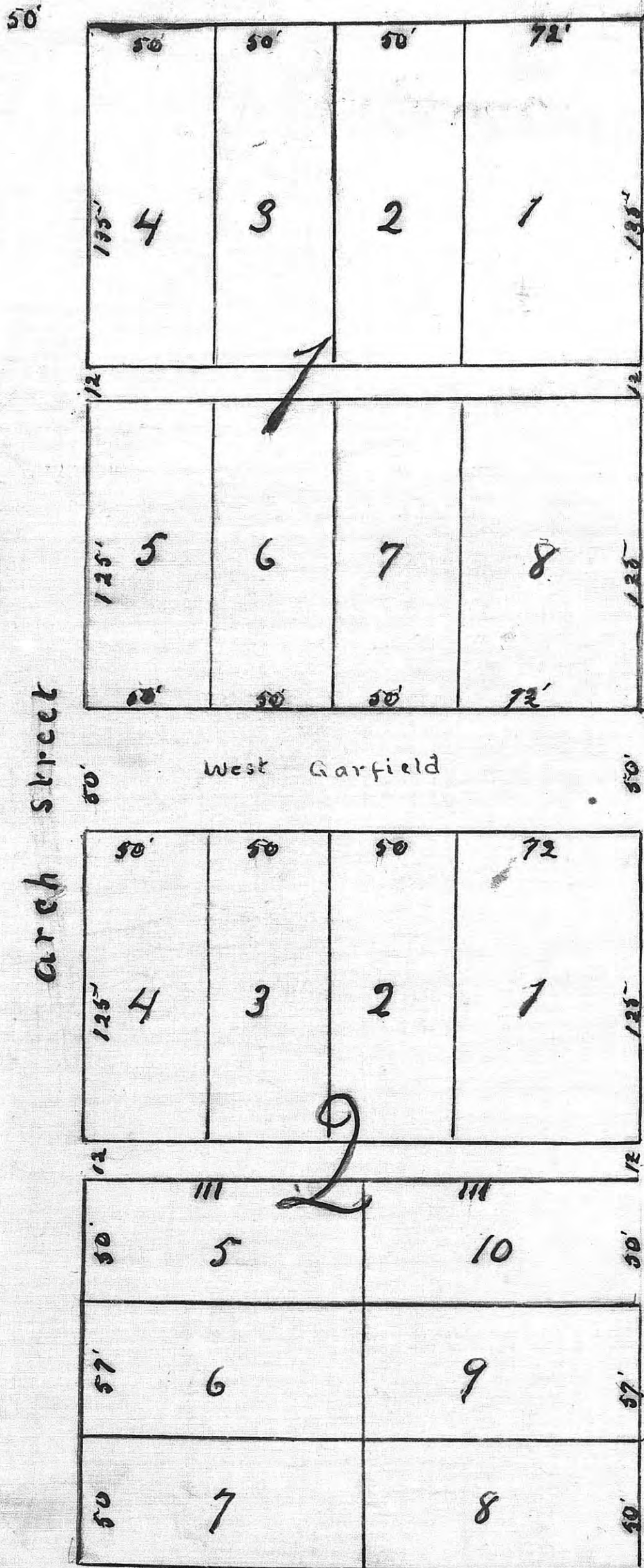


# KEAGY'S 4<sup>th</sup> Addition to ELLIS

Said survey is located in the south east portion of the N 2 of 36 of section 13 Twp 13 Range 26 and is as nearly in accord as can be determined with the out lines of Keagy's 4<sup>th</sup> addition to Ellis. Said plat fronts on 4 existing streets and is laid at right angles there to it being the intent of paralleling Arch and Monroe streets, so as to make them as nearly as possible identical with the original streets of that name.
