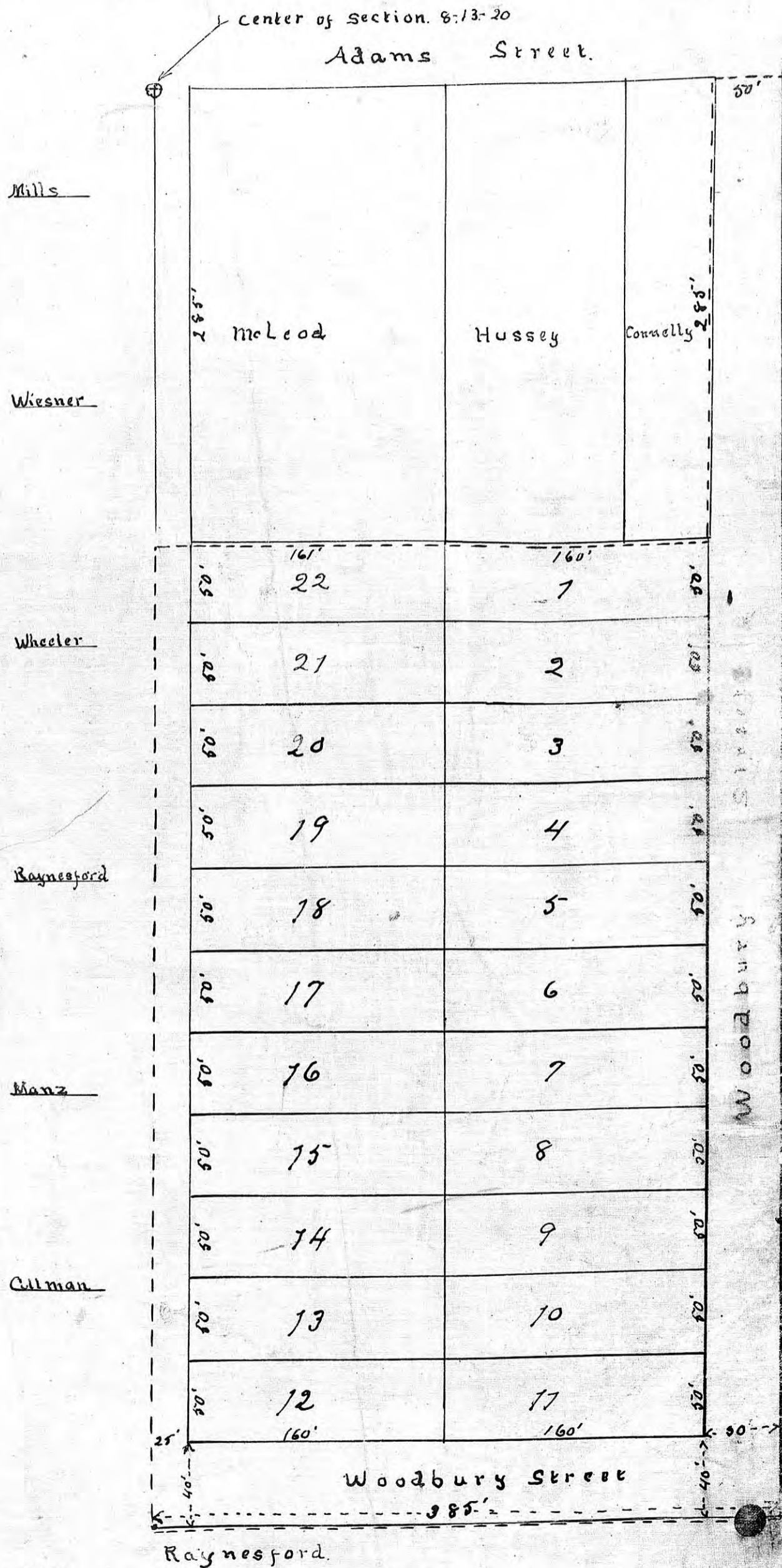


KEAGY'S 5TH ADDITION. To

--DEDICATION--

To plat of Keagy's 5th addition to Ellis.

State of Kansas, Ellis County, SS:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, the undersigned, Andrew B. Keagy (also known as Andrew Keagy and A. B. Keagy), a single man, residing in the city of Ellis, Ellis County, Kansas, being the owner of that portion of the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of section 8, township 13, range 20, covered by the plat hereinafter mentioned, have caused to be surveyed and platted the tract of land above mentioned, to be known as "Keagy's 5th addition to the City of Ellis, Kansas; and caused the plat thereof, to which this dedication is attached, to be duly filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Ellis County, Kansas. Said addition consists of one Block containing twenty-two lots numbered one to twenty-two (both inclusive), and is bounded on the East and South by Woodbury Street, on the West by the public road or street, running North and South along the East side of Hesse Bros. addition to Ellis, and on the North by certain unplatted tracts of land, on the South side of Adams Street. The dimensions of all lots and the width of all streets are noted and designated on said plat, and all streets and parts of streets noted, designated and indicated on said plat are hereby dedicated to the Public. Woodbury street extends north to the south line of Adams Street.

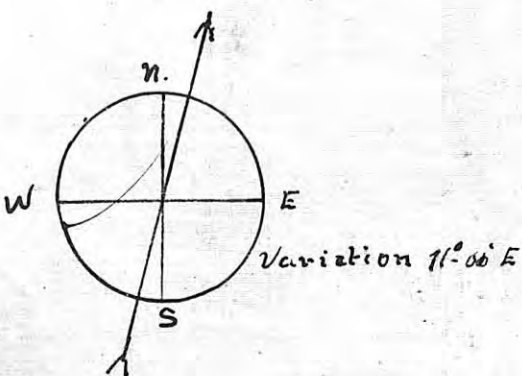
State of Kansas, Ellis County, SS:
