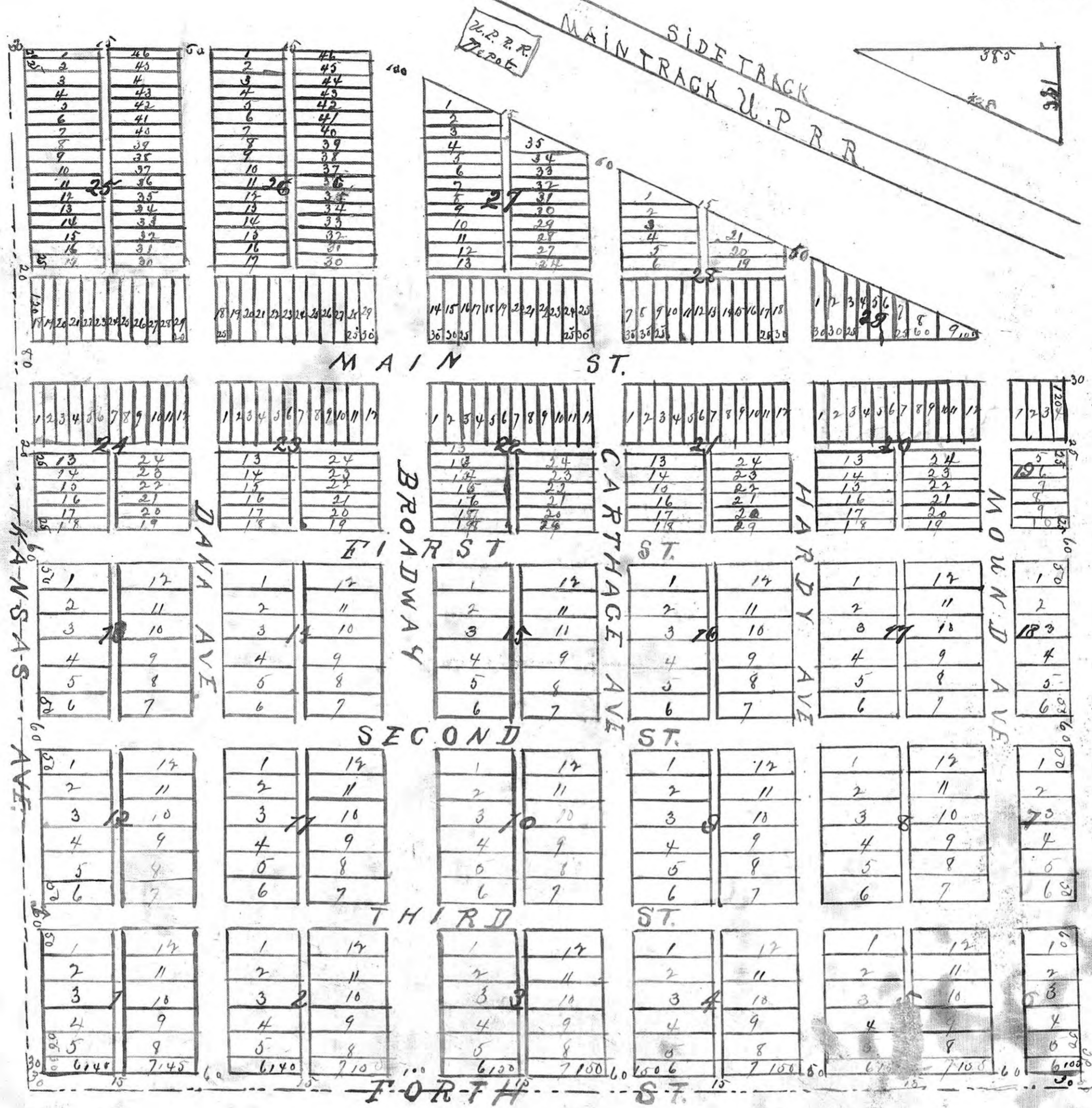


PLAT OF NITCHY KAN.
