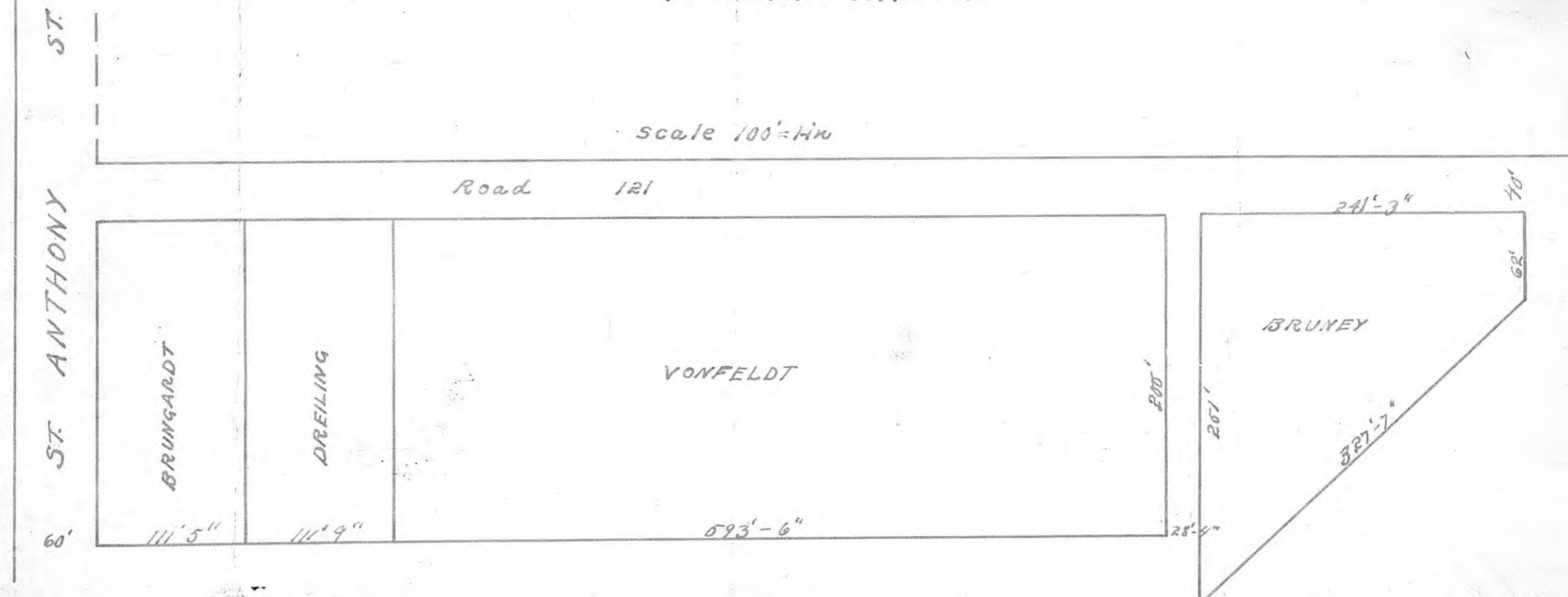

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS : That we, Susan Bruney, Joseph Vonfeldt, Nicholas Dreiling and Franz Brungardt, the undersigned, residents of the City of Victoria county and state aforesaid, have caused to be surveyed and platted for record in accordance with the laws of the State of Kansas a certain portion of the Southwest Quarter of Section Seven (7), Township Fourteen (14), Range Seventeen (17) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian lying, being and situate within the corporate limits of the City of Victoria of the County and State aforesaid and to be known and designated as "OVERLAND PLACE".

The plat hereto attached and made a part hereof is a true and correct plat of said "OVERLAND PLACE", showing streets by name, their courses, boundaries and extent.

The length and width of the several lots being indicated by figures on the plat. The length and width of all streets and alleys are shown on the plat in like manner.

All streets and alleys as shown on the plat are hereby dedicated for public use.
