Explanation:

Cemetery: Large boldfaced figures 1, 2, 3 & 4 are the block numbers & small figures on the lots are lot numbers.

a a, a a, are walks 7 ft wide on the north and south limits; b b, b b, are walks 6 feet wide on the east and west limits.

Passways running east and west, and are marked "2" along main drives, are 2 ft wide each.

d d, d d, Main drive, north and south, east and west, are 12 ft wide.

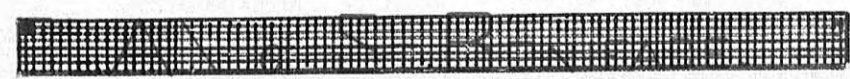
Passways marked "4" are 4 ft wide.

All burial lots measure from north to south 20 feet, and from east to west 18 feet.

The Cemetery enclosure measures from north to south 330 ft and from east to west 300 feet.

Dimensions and number of each lot are indicated for each residence lot.
