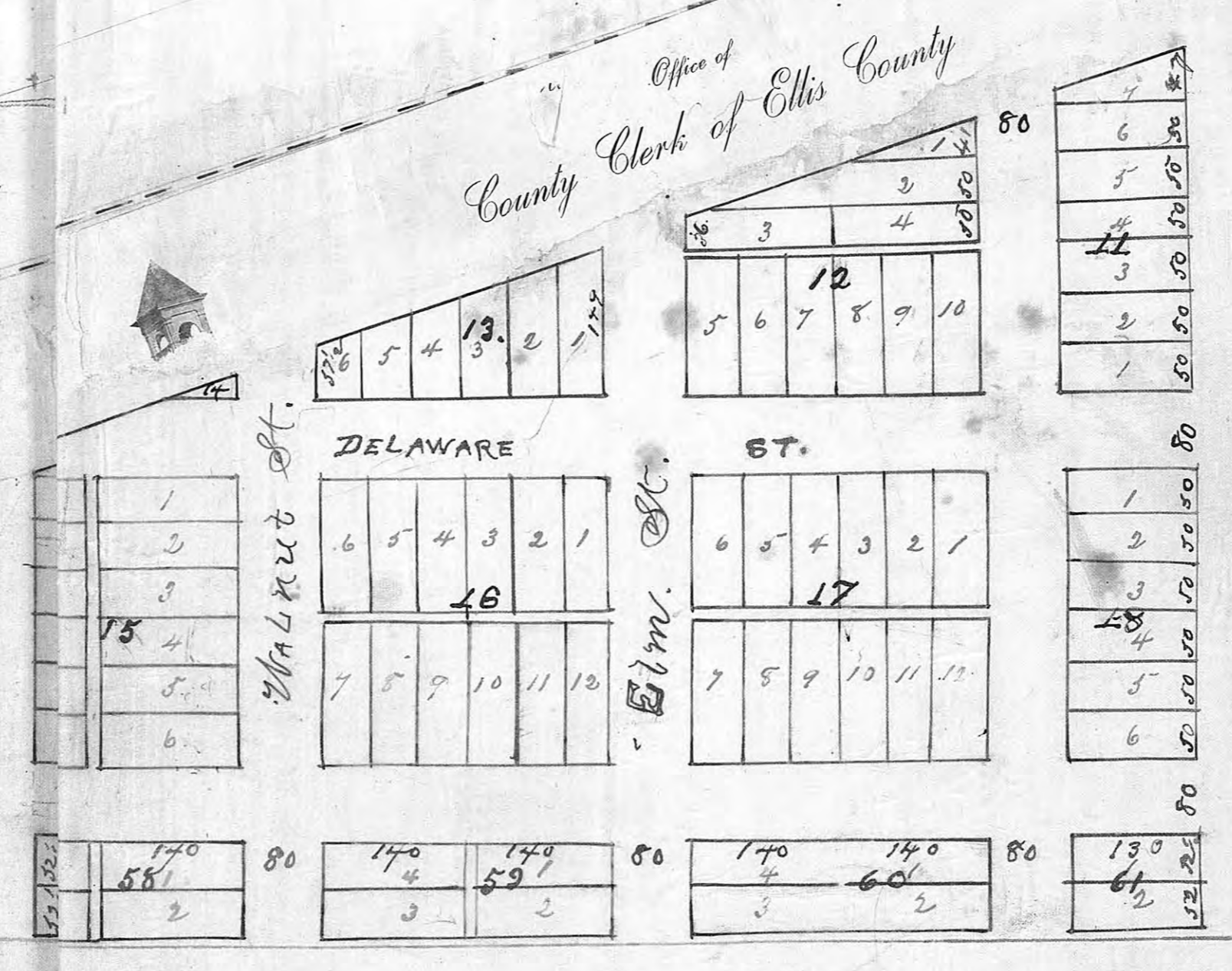


Original Walker

 W. L. Shull's map, r. 12, 10" that the point of com-
 monment and from which all the lots and streets
 located in town were run 40 feet South and 50
 feet of streets and alleys and the size of lots
 2 blocks are so represented on this plat in line
 figures, scale 150 feet to the inch. The
 where at the South West corner and the
 original plat of Walker are not included in this
 plat and should not be recorded.
